## THE TOWN OF SYKESVILLE

**RESOLUTION NO: 2021-01** 

A RESOLUTION of the Mayor and Council of The Town of Sykesville to authorize (1) the annexation of that certain real property described on attached <a href="Exhibit A">Exhibit A</a> (the "Property"), and (2) the entry into an agreement with the owners of the Property specifying the municipal services which will be provided for the benefit of the Property.

WHEREAS, The Town of Sykesville (the "Town") is a municipal corporation of the State of Maryland, organized and existing under the Charter adopted in 1965, and amended in 1993 (the "Charter");

WHEREAS, pursuant to §4-401 of the Local Government Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland (2013 Repl. Vol.), the Mayor and Council of the Town ("Council") are empowered to enlarge the corporate boundaries of the Town;

WHEREAS, the Property is 10.1109 acres of land located along the west side of School House Road and on the south side of Oklahoma Avenue in the Fifth Election District of Carroll County, Maryland;

WHEREAS, there are no registered voters in said area proposed to be annexed.

WHEREAS, the owners of not less than 25 percent (25%) of the assessed valuation of the real property located in said area proposed to be annexed have consented to such annexation;

WHEREAS, the presiding officer of the Council has made a verification of the consent of the owners of not less than twenty five percent (25%) of the assessed valuation of the real property located in the area proposed to be annexed; and

WHEREAS, the zoning designations for each parcel or partial parcel shall be zoned as follows:

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council find it necessary and in the best interests of the Town to annex the Property, pursuant to which this Resolution is adopted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN, that the parcels of real property described in <a href="Exhibit A">Exhibit A</a> shall be annexed to the Town and become part thereof;


FURTHER RESOLVED, that from and after the effective date of this Resolution, all persons residing in the area to be annexed, and their property, shall be added to the corporate boundaries of the Town and shall be subject to provisions of the charter and ordinances of the Town and any amendments thereto;

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor and the Town Manager of the Town, immediately upon the first publication of the public notice of the proposed annexation, shall provide a copy of the public notice to the County Commissioners of Carroll County and to any regional and state planning agencies having jurisdiction within said county;

FURTHER RESOLVED, that following the public hearing, the Town may enact said Resolution with its usual requirements and practices, to become effective no less than forty-five (45) days following final enactment. In the event a petition for referendum is received and verified pursuant to the provisions of §§4-408(b), 4-409(b) or 4-410(a) of the Local Government Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland within the forty-five (45) day period following final enactment of this Resolution, then the effectiveness of this Resolution shall be suspended, contingent upon results of the referendum to be held in conformity with the further requirements of §§4-411,4-412 and 4-413.

This Resolution is adopted by the Mayor and Council of The Town of Sykesville on the 12 day of 3027, 2021 to become effective forty-five (45) days from the date hereof.

## **DESCRIPITION OF PROPERTY TO BE ANNEXED**

## BY TOWN OF SYKESVILLE

(Note: Metes and Bounds described below are taken from individual surveys for each of the affected parcels)

BEGINNING at an iron pin with a broken cap marked "LS4799" on the north side of the CSX Railroad, said iron pin lying at Coordinate Point 7 shown on a Subdivision Plat entitled "Amended Plat of Lots 4 and 5 of Scarborough Woods. Sheet 2 of 2" and recorded among the Land Records of Carroll County in Plat Book 48, Page 123; thence binding reversely on all of the South 16° 48′ 06" West 326.70-foot line of said plat, and binding reversely on all of the 11<sup>th</sup> or South 12° West 19-4/5-perch line of that parcel of land which by deed dated April 11, 1901 and recorded among the Land Records in Liber 93, Folio 45 was conveyed by Frank Brown to Asa Hepner:

Sheet 1 of 2" and recorded among the Land Records of Carroll County in Plat Book 48, Page 122; thence leaving the outlines of said Subdivision Plat and binding reversely on all of the 8<sup>th</sup> or North 63-1/2° West 4-1/4-perch line of the abovementioned parcel conveyed in Liber 93, Folio 45, and binding on all of the 9<sup>th</sup> or South 63° East 70.12-foot line of that parcel of land which, by deed dated march 15, 1965 and recorded among the Land Records of Carroll County in Liber 386, Folio 197, was conveyed by Helen N. Williams and Roscoe C. Williams to Beatrice Johnson:

North 05° 45′ 55″ East a distance of 58.70 feet to the beginning of the 7<sup>th</sup> line of the deed dated August 19, 2015 and recorded among the Land Records of Carroll County in Liber 8089, Folio 205 conveyed by Gretchen Robinson unto Gretchen Robinson; thence binding on part of said 7<sup>th</sup> line:

North 05° 45′ 55″ East a distance of 84.50 feet to the end of the 4<sup>th</sup> or South 86° West 366.5-foot line of the first parcel of land which, by deed dated November 12, 2019 and recorded among the Land Records of Carroll County in Liber 9740, Folio 491 was conveyed by Robbinette Dorsey Whittaker, Personal Representative of the Estate of Agnes Geneva Dorsey, unto Robbinette T. Dorsey; thence binding reversely on part of said 4<sup>th</sup> line:

North 05° 45′ 55″ East a distance of 84.50 feet to a point on the south side of Oklahoma Road 10.5 feet from the corner of a concrete inlet on Oklahoma Road, said point being the beginning of the 2<sup>nd</sup> or North 86° East 354.4-foot line of the abovementioned parcel conveyed in Liber 9740, Folio 491:
- 9. North 80° 27′ 14″ East a distance of 40.87 feet to a point on the current limits of the Town of Sykesville; thence binding on said Town limits and running across the abovementioned first parcel of land conveyed in Liber 9740, Folio 491:

South 13° 44′ 11″ East a distance of 82.06 feet to a point on the 4<sup>th</sup> or South 86° West 366.5-foot line of the abovementioned first parcel conveyed in Liber 9740, Folio 491; thence binding on part of said 4<sup>th</sup> line and binding on part of that parcel believed to be owned by Walter Edward Johnson, Jr. and Edna Young Johnson:

Hepner unto the State of Maryland, said point lying about 8 feet south of a Railroad monument found; thence binding on part of said 5<sup>th</sup> line to the end thereof:

CONTAINING 401,434 square feet, or 10.1109 acres of land, more or less, as surveyed in November, 2020 by Shanaberger & Lane. The survey and this description were both prepared without benefit of a title report.
